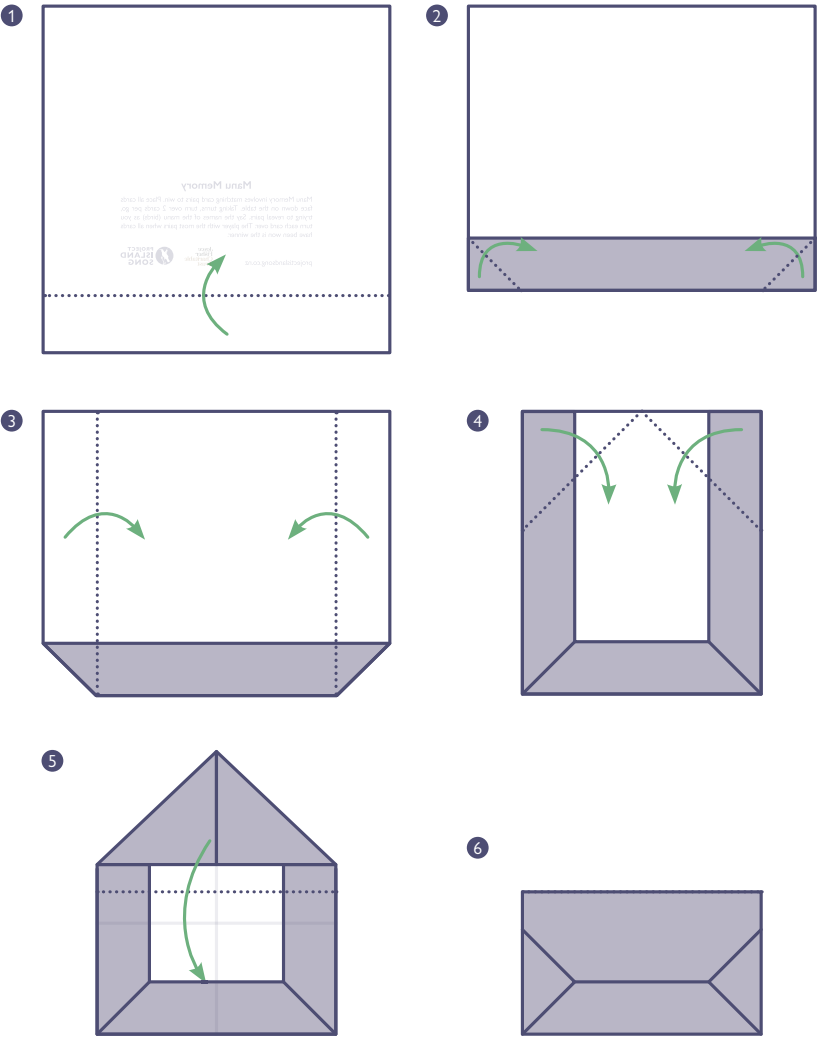

Manu Memory
